

Dunmanway Agricultural Show Prize Schedule

Sunday 5th July 2026



We want everyone to have an enjoyable day! To help us to achieve this, please abide by the rules, obey safety officers and stewards, and listen to announcements.

Rules and Regulations

1. Exhibits of Horticulture, Cookery, Needlework, Handicrafts and art will be judged at 4:00pm on Saturday (day before the show). Exhibitors please note - all entries in these classes must be in place by 3:30pm on Saturday and cannot be removed before 5:00pm on Sunday. Exhibitors must produce their Official Removal Card to the Stewards in charge of the various sections
2. No entries will be accepted after the stipulated closing date.
3. Entries must be accompanied by the Full Amount of the Entry Fee (Cheques, Money Orders, Postal Orders to be made payable to Dunmanway Agricultural Society CLG.) and must have all necessary details and information.
4. A person entering an Exhibit and failing to send same for exhibition shall forfeit the entry fee.
5. Exhibitors are reminded that whilst every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of exhibits, the Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage, nor will the Society be accountable for any accident that may occur to any person attending the show, be they visitor, exhibitor or otherwise.
6. Exhibitors accept that the Judges' decision is FINAL in all cases. ANY abuse/harassment of Judges/Stewards/Officials will not be tolerated. Where a dispute arises, the matter will be dealt with under Rule 7 and in accordance with the ISA disciplinary procedures as appropriate.
7. Objections in any class MUST be lodged in writing with the Secretary before 4:00pm on Show Day. All objections must be accompanied by a fee of €20.00, which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
8. No prize awarded unless 2 compete; no 2nd prize awarded unless 3 compete and no 3rd prize unless 5 compete. This rule will be waived should the Judge consider there is special merit and record same in their book at the time of judging.
9. The Society reserves the right of refusing entries, varying prize lists and arrangements, or removing any animal or other exhibit, at any time during the Show, and shall in no way be liable for any claim for compensation arising out of the holding of, or the abandonment or alteration of the date of the Show.
10. Should any objection be made to any successful animal in a class on the grounds of height, the Stewards of the class shall have the animal examined by the Society's Veterinary Surgeon, whose decision shall be final.
11. The pony section will be run under the Irish Pony Society Rules.
12. A parade of prize winners - horses and cattle will take place if possible and if an animal is absent from this parade, the exhibitor in question will be liable to forfeit the prize or prizes awarded to the animal in the absence of an adequate explanation.
13. First Prize winners in Horse, Pony and Cattle classes are debarred from further competition, except where otherwise stated. Winners of qualifiers may compete in other classes.
14. Refreshments will be supplied on the grounds.

15. The Prize List is issued subject to the General Rules and Conditions of the Society.
16. The Society has the option of cancelling or amalgamating any class where less than three entries have been received.
17. Young Horse Championship: Winners of the thoroughbred youngstock class are not eligible to compete for this championship.
18. Animals entered to compete in the Irish Draught Mare classes must be registered in the Irish Draught studbook and have a UELN.
19. All foals must be led at this show.
20. All entries in Horse classes must have an IHR number or equivalent.
21. Judging in the Horse Section must commence at 11:00am.
22. NO HAWKERS ALLOWED unless they produce their own public liability insurance and make appropriate arrangements with the Society prior to the show.
23. Exhibitors of animals are requested to have their own Insurance Cover & Public Liability.
24. The Irish Shows Association Levy of 5% will be deducted from all prize money in the relevant sections: horses, ponies, donkeys, cattle, sheep.
25. Winners of qualifiers are themselves responsible for entering their animals (or exhibits) for the FINAL. On completion of judging, they must attend the Show Secretary's Office within ONE HOUR, and complete the necessary documentation and pay entry fee for the FINAL.
26. The Society will not be responsible for any errors in either Entry Forms, Schedule, or Show Book.
27. Cars are parked at owners' risk.
28. Any handler whose animal is not under his/her control may be asked to remove said animal from the arena or show field at the discretion of the Safety Officers, Judge or Stewards.
29. Trade Stand Owners must have their own Public Liability Insurance Certificate.
30. All Exhibitors must display their numbers so that they can be easily seen and read.
31. Safety Officers must be obeyed at all times.
32. Stallions are not eligible to compete in the Horse and Pony Sections due to insurance regulations.
33. Only competent persons are allowed to exhibit animals.
34. Bulls must be led with a pole and be under the control of two people at all times.
35. All cattle entries must comply with Department of Agriculture regulations.
36. In the Cattle Section, it has been ruled that a Heifer is a Heifer until she calves; then she is in the Cow Class.
37. All entries must be in the Show Book - insurance regulations.
38. One person only will be admitted free with each livestock exhibit, but two persons may be admitted with a bull.
39. Cups and Trophies must be returned to the Society before closing date for entries. Dunmanway Agricultural Society requires the signature of the Perpetual Cup / Trophy winners for receipt of same from the show. The person to whom the Cup / Trophy is awarded gives an undertaking that the Cup / Trophy will be returned to the Show Secretary in as good a condition as it was received, at least 14 days prior to the date of the succeeding show. NO PERPETUAL CUP / TROPHY CAN BE WON OUTRIGHT.

Important Notice to Animal Owners Involved in the Show

The Irish Shows Association would advise all animal owners who have their animals insured to have the insurance cover extended to cover them while showing animals at shows.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. This competition is to encourage growers to exhibit fruit and vegetables from their own kitchen garden or allotment and promote the benefits of eating local produce.
2. Each exhibit must consist of a display of fresh in-season, fruit and vegetables excluding potatoes.
3. The display must contain between 7 to 10 kinds of fruit and vegetables. The display must contain a minimum of 2 kinds of fruit. Tomatoes are classified as a vegetable for this competition. Foliage and root growth may be trimmed for display purposes, and herbs may be included as garnish
4. The vegetables and fruit must be displayed within an area not larger than 610mm x 610mm (24"x24") However, foliage and roots may extend beyond that boundary but not rest on the show bench.
5. Exhibitors may use their own staging board or container at qualifying shows.
6. At the final, all qualifying exhibitors will be supplied with a uniform 610mm x 610mm (24"x24") container for the presentation of their fruit and vegetables. The use of additional staging, containers, plates, boards, or accessories is not permitted.
7. At the final, qualifying exhibitors may set up their displays on Saturday evening between 6:00pm and 9:00pm, and on Sunday morning between 7:00am and 9.30am. Exhibits must not be removed before 5:00pm on Sunday.
8. Marquee opens from 7.00am on show morning and will be closed for judging at 10am sharp. Marquee will open to the public at 12 noon.
9. Exhibits cannot be removed before 5.00 pm.

3. The competition is confined to amateurs, with one entry per exhibitor at the final.
4. The items must be fresh, and home baked by exhibitor.
5. In the event of an objection and following an investigation, and if the exhibitor is deemed to be making their living from their profession, they may be disqualified.
6. A special class will be held at each qualifying show. **Two entries** may qualify from these shows for the final, if judges agree that the standard is high enough. The Qualifiers from each of these shows will go forward to the final, to be held at the Tullamore Show, on Sunday August 9th.
7. Non adherence to tray sizes will deem elimination of exhibit.
8. All items will be cut and/or sampled by the judge.
9. Each of the successful qualifiers will receive a hamper containing Odlums products, on appearance at the final.
10. Certificates will be awarded to the finalists.
11. The judge's decision at all stages of the competition, IS FINAL.
12. Exhibits are displayed at owner's risk.

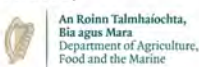

CATTLE

Animal Health Status

TB - Bovine Tuberculosis Eradication Programme

All animals must come from herds, which are Officially TB free (OTF - i.e., not restricted) and the herd and relevant animals must have had a clear test within the previous 12 months - this test must be recorded on the Department's Animal Health Computer System (AHCS). Animals which have disclosed inconclusive reactor results are not permitted to be moved for the purpose of exhibition at shows.

From 13 April 2026, dairy cows that move from a show to a different herd must have been tested in the previous 30 days prior to movement. For all other cows of any age, or a male over the age of 36 months, moves from a show to a different herd it must have had a TB test in the last 6 months and the herd from which it is coming from must have had a herd test within the previous 6 months of its movement into the new Herd. For further information see new bovine TB testing requirements for animal movements on www.bovinetb.ie

Bovine Viral Diarrhoea (BVD)

All bovine animals must have a negative BVD status for BVD virus (not antibody) when moving, including to shows, within the state. Animals entering the state, including Northern Ireland, must have a negative BVD viral antigen and a valid E.U. Health Certificate.

Identification, Registration, Movement Inspections

The restriction of a holding for noncompliance with IDR related issues will also impact movement of bovine to a show for the period of the restriction.

Bovine Identification & Mandatory Electronic Identification of bovines (EID)

Mandatory electronic identification (EID) of bovines has been implemented with effect from 1st July 2022. This means that all bovine animals born on or after 1st July 2022 must be identified with 2 official flag tags, one of which contains an EID component. All bovines born prior to 1st July 2022 must continue to bear 2 official flag tags as heretofore. There is no mandatory requirement that bovines in this age category bear an official EID tag.

Passports

All bovines attending shows must be accompanied by their passports.

Animal Identification and Movement (AIM) Notification

1. The movement of cattle to and from an Agricultural Show/Fair within the State must be recorded on the AIM System.
2. With effect from 4 February 2019 there is a specific Certificates of Compliance for the "Movement of Bovine from a Single Holding to a Show", form NBAS 31K refers.

3. The herd keeper must obtain the Certificate of Compliance prior to the movement of animals. The certificate can be created by (i) using herd keepers' on-line facility or (ii) where the keeper is not on-line the certificate can be generated by the local Regional Veterinary Office (RVO) following receipt of a completed form NBAS 31K.
4. The creation of a certificate is subject to normal movement criteria such as clear TB test etc.
5. A copy of form NBAS 31K is included at Appendix 2 and will also be available on www.gov.ie.
6. When applying for this certificate, the Show/Fair number is not required. The certificate generated will include an "S" symbol.
7. The Certificate of Compliance for a show will continue to be valid for a period of up to 28 days. As is currently the case, these can be used for the movement of animal/s to several shows during the validity period of the certificate. Requests to the RVO should be provided with sufficient time to allow for the certificate to be generated and issued especially where one cert expires, and another is required immediately. Keepers who are likely to attend at consecutive shows are strongly advised to apply using herd keepers' on-line facility. The ability to create and print a certificate immediately (subject to the bovine meeting the relevant criteria) will remove issues which can arise where a certificate is already in place and a further certificate is required.
8. Calves which are less than 10 days old cannot be moved to a Show.
9. The Movement Notification Section of the Certificate should be completed and signed by the keeper. The form should also be signed and stamped by the Show Secretary who must clearly indicate the Show Number. The Show movement must be recorded on the passport. Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling these requirements lies with the Show Secretary.
10. If the animal/s move from the show to a herd other than the source herd, the new destination herd must also sign the certificate.
11. Completed forms must be sent by the Show Secretary to the local RVO within seven days of the Show. Failure to have movements recorded within the required time scale may have implications for the herd keeper/s involved.

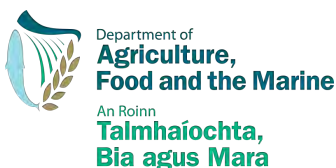

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS - SHEEP

Identification

All sheep must be identified individually with appropriate ear tags issued in accordance with the requirements of the National Sheep Identification System (NSIS).

Movement Documentation

All consignments of sheep being moved must be accompanied by a completed dispatch document. Individual details of each sheep in the consignment must be recorded on the document. Sheep from non-restricted flocks only can be moved to shows. In the case of flocks restricted following diagnosis of scrapie, sheep possessing the ARR/ARR genotype only may be exhibited. The movement of these ARR/ARR genotype sheep must be accompanied by the relevant movement permit (SCR/10), which can be obtained from the Regional Veterinary Office responsible for the county in which the flock is located.

AIM Notification

The movement of sheep to and from an Agricultural Show within the State must be recorded on AIM. This is done using a copy of the owner's sheep dispatch document as follows:

1. The owner/keeper presents the signed and completed dispatch document to the show secretary who checks it to ensure that it is completed in full.
2. The show secretary fills in the MART section of the dispatch document with (i) the show number, (ii) the date of the move back to the source holding (iii) stamps it with the show stamp and (iv) signs the dispatch document.
3. The show secretary then forwards the completed pink section of the dispatch document to the local RVO within 7 days of the show movement.
4. The show secretary keeps the white copy for their records.
5. The source/destination keeper keeps the bottom yellow copy to enter it into their flock register.

Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling this requirement lies with the Show Secretary.
